

FAITH

FXW is an independent, Catholic school where all students experience and gain an understanding of religious diversity.

CATHOLIC MULTIFAITH

In Preschool and Kindergarten, the experience of faith is rooted in the student's imagination and filled with stories of awe and wonder of God. In first through eighth grade, students participate in either a Catholic religion class (Moonbeams) or an interfaith religion class (Shooting Stars). Both curricula mirror one another. Throughout the year, children participate in ecumenical prayer services and masses as an expression of their faith experience. As an intentionally inclusive community, FXW School values the opportunity for interfaith dialogue, which involves listening, learning, and asking questions to deepen our students' understanding of world religions. The celebration of Catholic holy days and sacramental preparation are part of the Catholic religion program.

During the 2020–2021 school year, our team quickly pivoted to a virtual platform with Old St. Patrick's Church and Holy Name Cathedral to bring our community together.



SERVICE

A Community motivated by faith to serve others

Through the Living the Legacy (LTL) service projects, FXW students and families engage in meaningful service opportunities throughout Chicago. Service comes in many forms including serving hot meals, cleaning up parks and beaches, and more.

Due to COVID-19, FXW could not host community service events as it typically does. Over the years, FXW has more than 30 partnerships with organizations across the city with more than 200 service projects logged.

Undeterred, FXW maintained its mission of service with dozens of in-classroom service events and all-school initiatives including a book collection for Big Shoulders for Valentine's Day, hosting a collection drive at OSP/HNC for The Night Ministry and creating Valentine's Day cards for healthcare workers at Rush University Medical Center and University of Chicago Medical Center.



Some Key Highlights from our Service

Coordinated a delivery of **75 Easter centerpieces** for Mission of Our Lady of the Angels in West Humboldt Park.

The Thanksgiving Drive produced enough food to pack over **200 complete boxes of Thanksgiving dinners**. FXW families donated \$2,945 to purchase turkeys and provide a full Thanksgiving meal and pantry items for five of our families in need.

ACADEMICS

A Community that is preparing thinkers and leaders in an academically enriched environment

From Preschool to Grade 8, FXW provides a rigorous academic program focusing on the whole child. In addition, FXW offers fine arts, STEM, enrichment offerings, and Athletics. Of primary focus is communicating student progress, technology, and social emotional learning.





The 2020-2021 school year began in a hybrid model. Students were divided into two cohorts—A and B. Each cohort was on campus for two days of in-person learning and three days of remote learning. This was to minimize exposure to the COVID-19 virus while in school. Teachers taught students at home and in the classroom, which required our students to establish new routines and structure to their dayto-day learning. The School's Social Emotional Learning Team provided support to families and students on how to maintain a schedule that provided students with a continuation of learning with necessary support. In March of 2021, we welcomed all our students back to the classroom for in-person learning five days a week.

DIVERSITY AND INCLUSION

A Community that is purposefully diverse and intentionally inclusive

As we planned for a return to campus, we found ourselves focused on the health, safety, and wellbeing of our students, families and staff not only from COVID-19 but also from the protests and calls for change in response to the murder of George Floyd, and countless others. FXW saw this as an opportunity to expand our efforts around supporting Equity and Justice.

The Equity and Justice Forum (EJF) was created and charged with 1) providing a space and place for listening, dialogue, and greater understanding about race and racism in our country, especially ideas for dealing with current challenges and planning for a better future, and 2) serving as a catalyst for bridging differences regarding race in America, promoting reconciliation, and encouraging fresh perspectives.






A product of our Maggie Daley Speaker Series focused on launching a Community Conversation on Race. Nationally recognized diversity experts Dr. Derrick Gaye and Dr. Amanda Lewis were both present to share their thoughts and experiences, and to respond to questions that weighed heavily upon our community. Parents asked about how they can better educate their children, how to talk about racism and the tragic experiences of People of Color, and how to support FXW in our equity and justice efforts.

The Equity and Justice Forum is comprised of parents, faculty, staff, and alumni parents.






Scholarship

ATHLETICS & CO-CURRICULARS

The Frances Xavier Warde School (FXW) values the education of students both inside and outside of the classroom. During the 2020-2021 school year, 187 students participated in the School's sports pilot program created in response to COVID-19. More than 200 students participated in the co-curricular program. Following the cohort model of the classroom, small groups of athletes worked on individual skill development and cross country ran at Lake Shore Park in small cohort groups.

FXW's co-curricular programs are designed to provide students with a safe and stimulating environment in which to learn, play, and be active. From athletics to fine arts, students participate and compete in activities that nurture and expand their personal interests. FXW's commitment to each child's well-being is fulfilled when their mind, body, and spirit work together. Virtual programs offered during this unusual year included debate team, extended day program, French club, geometry, scholastic bowl and trigonometry.







INVESTING IN FXW

As the FXW experience is unique in our city, it requires a shared commitment to the mission and vision of the School. The FXW community strongly believes in this commitment as is demonstrated by the annual generosity of time, talent, and treasure from the faculty, staff, parents, alumni, and alumni parents.

Mother Warde Fund

Guided by Mother Warde's generous and unyielding example, we created the Mother Warde Fund to help address the pressing needs of our community. All-encompassing of previous fundraising initiatives such as the FXW Fund and Gala, **The Mother Warde Fund** was our singular focus for the year as we worked to ensure our learning programs remained robust in the classroom and while learning off campus, our facilities remained safe for all our students, and our School remained financially accessible for all our families. **Collectively, our community raised more than \$900,000 to support the Mother Warde Fund effort.**



PARENT ADVISORY COUNCIL

The Parent Advisory Committee (PAC) is a parent-run group that supports the mission of FXW. PAC is the consolidation the former Parent Group Advisory Board (PGAB) and Parents at the Heart (PATH) into one parent organization. The Parent Advisory Committee serves as a resource for the community and works with faculty, staff, and families to promote FXW spirit by coordinating community-building events, school support and volunteer opportunities. Through the leadership and generosity of time and commitment, our PAC volunteers help to oversee the following aspects of FXW:
